Labelling Biohazardous Waste

Updated: Sept 2023 Supersedes: July 2012

All biohazardous waste receptacles in the lab must be clearly labelled with Biohazard tape so that all parties, including caretaking, can unmistakably identify these containers. Please ensure the tape goes around the entire container and that it is in a spot that will not be covered by an autoclave bag. This tape is available from the Health Safety and Well-being, Support Services Building Room 4159.

Biohazard containers purchased from a supplier that are already clearly marked do not need to be taped.

All biohazardous material for autoclaving is to be placed in an autoclave bag before leaving the lab. Waste must then be autoclaved and verified for decontamination as per current Western Autoclaving and Verification Standard Operating Procedures.
